Students accepted into an early entry program are subject to the same policies as other matriculated graduate students. Early entry students should finish their baccalaureate degrees before they complete 15 hours of graduate work. Graduate level coursework may only be applied to a graduate degree if taken after the student is accepted into the graduate program.
